



Since 2007, the **Kamalini Vocational Training Centre** has trained two thousand underprivileged girls and women from Delhi and taught them entrepreneurial skills. Through training and good coaching, they have grown into self-assured and skilled women, who are able to start their own business or have a greater chance of a job with future prospects.

Every year in India about 1.5 million underage girls marry, many of them are married off. As a result, they leave education early. Poverty and lack of education of the parents contribute to this phenomenon.

Kamalini offers young women the opportunity to return to education; they are the key to a thriving future for family and society.

- High quality education
- Standards and values such as:
 - Involvement and service
 - Solidarity and responsibility
 - Honesty and transparency in business operations



The position of women in India

Only 29% of the labour force are women
More than 50% of women do unpaid work
50% has no mobile phone
50% does not have their own bank or savings account
60% has no valuables

92% of women in the capital Delhi have experienced sexual or physical violence in the public space.

Women with an income spend **90%** of it on their families. Economically independent and empowered women raise the standard of living in India. They also usually have healthier and better educated children.

For 200 euros someone in Kamalini can be educated in such a way that she can start her own business. In 2020 we want to raise money and hope to pay the tuition fees for 25 women.
